

8. Soldering and Mounting

(1) Soldering

Mildly activated rosin fluxes are preferred. The minimum amount of solder can lead to damage from the stresses caused by the difference in coefficients of expansion between solder, chip and substrate. BULL WILL terminations are suitable for re-flow soldering systems. If hand soldering cannot be avoided, the preferred technique is the utilization of hot air soldering tools.

(2) Solder re-flow:


Recommended temperature profiles for re-flow soldering in Figure 1.

(3) Soldering Iron:

Products attachment with a soldering iron is discouraged due to the inherent process control limitations. In the event that a soldering iron must be employed the following precautions are recommended.

- · Preheat circuit and products to 150 $^{\circ}\mathrm{C}$
- · Never contact the ceramic with the iron tip
- Use a 20 watt soldering iron with tip diameter of 1.0mm

- · 355℃ tip temperature (max)
- 1.0mm tip diameter (max)
- Limit soldering time to 4~5sec.









9. Friendly reminder

- (1) When there are questions concerning measurement result : measurement shall be made after 48 \pm 2 hours of recovery under the standard condition
- (2) This power choke coil itself does not have any protective function in abnormal condition such as overload, short-circuit and open-circuit conditions, etc. Therefore, it shall be confirmed as the end product that there is no risk of smoking, fire, dielectric withstand voltage, insulation resistance, etc. in abnormal conditions to provide protective devices and/or protection circuit in the end product.
- (3) When this power choke coil was used in a similar or new product to the original one, sometimes it might not be able to satisfy the specifications due to different condition of use.
- (4) Dielectric withstanding test with higher voltage than specific value will damage insulating material and shorten its life.
- (5) This power choke coil must not be used in wet condition by water, coffee or any liquid because insulation strength becomes very low in this condition.
- (6) Please consult our company to confirm the reliability of the process required to wash or use or exposure to a chemical solvent used in this product.





- · Storage Conditions
- To maintain the solderability of terminal electrodes:
- 1. BULL WILL products meet IPC/JEDEC J-STD-020D standard-MSL, level 1.
- 2. Temperature and humidity conditions: Less than 40℃ and 60% RH.
- 3. Recommended products should be used within 12 months form the time of delivery.
- 4. The packaging material should be kept where no chlorine or sulfur exists in the air.
- Transportation
 - 1. Products should be handled with care to avoid damage or contamination from perspiration and skin oils.
 - 2. The use of tweezers or vacuum pick up is strongly recommended for individual components.
 - 3. Bulk handling should ensure that abrasion and mechanical shock are minimized.
